Why 2024 GO Mensch?

The term *Anthropocene* was coined in Mainz by Prof. Paul Crutzen in order to describe the influence of the Mensch (human being) on our planet or "the human dominance of biological, chemical and geological processes on earth." Human activities have increasingly become the driving force behind environmental changes, causing irreparable damage to our planet. Understanding the Anthropocene is therefore essential for understanding the present climate crisis.

Focusing on the Anthropocene also helps us to examine our own carbon footprint as a human beings and to consider our own actions and responsibilities. "GO Mensch" will address environmental issues in a multidisciplinary way, explore our impact on the environment and discuss ways to minimize our carbon footprint. By embracing this epoch, we recognize our collective power to shape a resilient and thriving future for our planet.
