Our Global Outreach Projects offer education for global citizenship which aims to equip all participants with the skills and understanding to take responsibility, value diversity and play an active part in European democratic life today.

To this end, the JGU Scotland HUB at Johannes Gutenberg-Universität Mainz (JGU) is organising a Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) called "2025 GO Wasser".

What is "2025 GO Wasser"?

- ✓ A collaborative, multidisciplinary and international Global Outreach project.
- ✓ Two weeks in Rheinland-Pfalz to work on projects related to climate change and our carbon footprint.
- ✓ A virtual exchange before and after the project, as part of the BIP.
- ✓ An opportunity to gain a multifaceted view on the topic by attending interdisciplinary academic courses at JGU.
- Excursions to various places in Rheinland-Pfalz.

And a chance to learn German: You can also attend an optional two-week German language course in Mainz before the start of the project (Mon 02 June – Fri 13 June 2025).



Why "Wasser"?

As a global community, we face unprecedented environmental challenges. Understanding how "Wasser" (water) and climate change interact is more important than ever as the devastating floods in our Ahrtal region in Rheinland-Pfalz (2021) or in Spain (2024) have shown us.

Water is a vital resource that sustains life, supports ecosystems, and drives economies. However, climate change significantly impacts water availability and quality, leading to severe consequences for communities worldwide. In this project, we will explore how climate change impacts our health and ecosystems and discuss how we can respond to this challenge.

"GO Wasser" will address the interconnectedness of water and climate change in a multi- disciplinary way. By talking to experts and working in teams, you will have the chance to identify your own carbon footprint and become an informed advocate for a sustainable future.
